Starting point: in front of the Crescent Theatre, in Sheepcote Street on the western corner of Brindley Place.

You can walk as much or as little as you wish at your own pace. Bring your camera!

We offer a modest 2 km walk, which you can do at your own pace and with as many rests, coffees and sight-seeing pauses as you like.

You will go around the cultural centre of the city, incorporating the most evocative streets at the historic centre of Birmingham, still criss-crossed by canals, passing the main monuments and architectural features of this important city. Brindley Place is where you may spend most time over the week as it is full of restaurants, cafés, coffee shops and pubs.

If you choose, you can buy a trip on a canal.

Make a note of interesting eating places and watering-holes for use during the week. The impressive city library is shut on Sunday, but if you explore during the week do try visiting its roof garden.

On Sunday, several stewards will be positioned around the area to help, explain local history, point the way, advise on the nearest coffee shop for a refreshing break and generally ensure you have a rewarding time.
